If you reside in QLD and would like to obtain a White Card, you will need to provide three forms of ID that shows evidence of your full name, date of birth, your signature, and a photo.

This can be a combination of documents such as:

- Photo ID such as a current Australian driver's licence, Queensland Card 18+ (laminated), or an Australian Passport
- An original full birth certificate
- A Medicare card

If you reside in WA and would like to obtain a Construction Industry Training Card (CIT) you will need to provide ID. This could include:

Current Western Australian Driver's Licence; or  
Current Western Australian learner driver's permit; or  
Current Western Australian Student Identification; or  
Recent utilities invoice with a Western Australia address and the name of the person to whom the CIT card will be issued
