CPC31420 Certificate III in Construction Waterproofing

The CPC31420 Certificate III in Construction Waterproofing is a trade level qualification and provides students with necessary skills and knowledge required to perform various waterproofing tasks to prevent damage from water or damp on construction sites.

This waterproofing course will prepare you to work on both interior and exterior areas in the residential and commercial construction industry.

Please note: Completion of the general induction training program specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction Training for Construction Work (ASCC 2007) is required before entering a construction work site. Achievement of unit CPCCOHS1001A, CPCCWHS1001A or CPCWHS1001 (White Card) covers this requirement but is not included within this course.

In signing the training contract, both parties are bound by certain obligations expressed in the contract. The training contract sets out the terms of the apprenticeship or traineeship, which are agreed to by both the employer and the apprentice or trainee.
