What is this qualification?

This course introduces you to the construction industry. You'll learn about workplace culture, different jobs, and what employers expect. The course covers essential skills including work health and safety, industry organisation, communication, work planning, and basic tool use.

How does the course work?

The qualification is built around a hands-on construction project. This project brings together all the skills you're learning and helps you develop the work habits that employers value.

Who is this course for?

This qualification is perfect for students in VET programs at school, or anyone who has never worked in construction before. You don't need any previous experience or qualifications to start.

What happens after I finish?

While this qualification doesn't lead directly to a specific job, it gives you the skills to move on to a Certificate II course or start an Australian Apprenticeship in construction.

Safety requirement

Before you can visit any construction site, you must complete the unit "Prepare to work safely in the construction industry" (CPCCWHS1001). This meets the legal requirements for workplace safety training and is mandatory for anyone entering the construction industry.
